In an FHO model, physicians are paid a flat rate amount for providing medical care for their patients as determined by their age and sex. The amount a family physician can earn is also determined by their roster size and expenses. Possibly eligible for income stabilization and newcomer stipend as well as substantial private incentives at some locations.

Physicians will apply for their own personal and professional benefits through the Ontario Medical Association or insurance provider of choice.
